

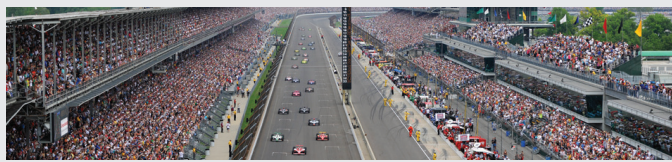
TOP ATTRACTIONS FOR SPORTS FANS

Indy's newest attraction, **Dallara IndyCar Factory**, opened its doors to visitors last summer offering street legal IndyCar rides, tours of a working factory making real IndyCars, racing simulators, and more.

The first car to win the Indianapolis 500 is on display at the **Indianapolis Motor Speedway**, along with hundreds of other IndyCar models.

Shoot hoops in a 1930's-style gym or enjoy a downhill skiing simulator at the **NCAA Hall of Champions**, which pays homage to its 23 sports.

The **National Art Museum of Sport** features the largest collection of sports art in the U.S. and includes paintings by Muhammad Ali.

NCAA SWIMMING & DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

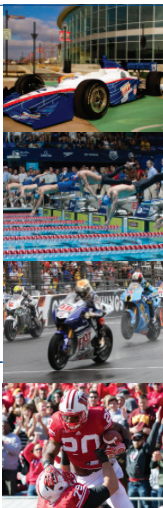
Women's: March 21-23, 2013 • IU Natatorium
